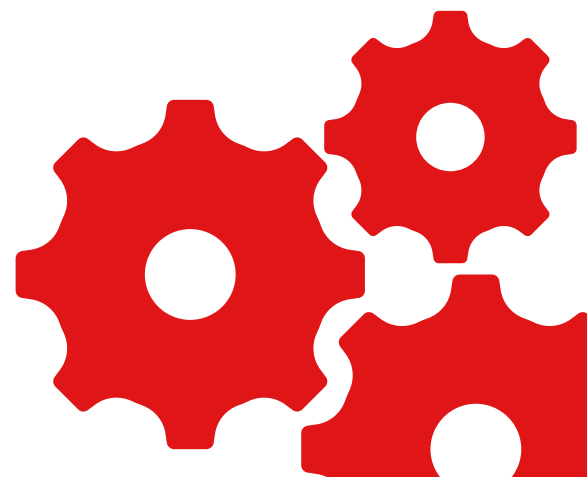

Cash-strapped college students receive a lifeline from construction company

Fourteen Majuba TVET College students whose NSFAS (National Students Financial Aid Scheme) applications were rejected have been handed a lifeline by CBMI Construction, in partnership with Brochem CISA, a chrome company based in Newcastle.

Each of the students, which include 12 engineering students, one construction student and one student studying hospitality, have received a bursary from CBMI which covers the full cost of their tuition for the 2023 academic year.

Vice general manager of CBMI, Tina Liou, addressed the recipients of the bursaries on Friday, January 20, saying she is grateful for the opportunity to contribute towards skills development in the community.

Liou was accompanied by the regional director of CBMI Africa, Xing Ming Li, CBMI's subsidiary company director and general manager, Deng Qiang Liu, project manager, Wen Fu Gao, and human resources manager, Dong Dong Jin, when she met with students and staff of Majuba College last week to officially announce the bursary recipients.

"South Africa's youth are the pillar of

the country and skills are the engine of economic growth. We see ourselves as the key to unlocking your potential," Liou said to the students. "We want you to focus on your studies and leave the money to us."

Providing a little background on the companies that made the bursaries possible, Liou explained that CBMI is currently involved in building an extension plant at Brochem, situated at the Karbochem site in Newcastle.

The new extension is expected to increase the production capacity for organic chrome powder by 50 000 tons, according to Liou.

"When the extension plant is completed, Brochem will need both skilled and unskilled staff to run the plant, creating a number of permanent job opportunities," promised Liou.

"CBMI's policy is to recruit locally as much as possible and 100 per cent of our general workers come from the local community. However, it is a sometimes challenge to find skilled engineers in the local community. That is why we want to contribute towards education to ensure that more people are employable as skilled artisans," she continued.

"My company is based in Johannesburg, and we are currently working on construction projects in Johannesburg, North West Province, and the Eastern Cape, besides KwaZulu-Natal. We believe that education is the key to overcoming poverty and, in our experience, it remains a challenge to find qualified, skilled people to work in our industry in South Africa. Our company would like to support education and provide young people with training opportunities at our company once they have completed their courses.

In doing so, we hope to make a difference."

Partnership and linkages manager at Majuba College, Deepak Mohan, said beneficiaries were selected according to academic performance from among a pool of students who had been rejected for NSFAS funding, either because they didn't qualify for some reason, or if there was an issue with how they submitted their applications.

"We highly appreciate the partnership we have established with CBMI and Brochem and we are grateful for the bursaries that they have made available. The recipients are from disadvantaged

backgrounds and the opportunity to further their studies means a lot to them. Most of the beneficiaries were selected from among the engineering students due to the nature of the work that the donor company specialises in," said Mohan.

Referring to an incident which took place last year, when protestors blocked the entrance to the Brochem site demanding jobs when they learned of the construction of the new extension, Liou concluded with this message to the community:

"We want the community to understand that CBMI is only here (in Newcastle) to do the project we were hired to complete. While we are here, our principle is to recruit as many people from the local community as possible.

However, we will bring in our own team of skilled artisans where we may not find the skills we are looking for in the community. We are a very law abiding company and we always ensure that everything we do is done according to South African law. If there are any voices in the community who feel they are not being heard, we urge them to get it touch and communicate with us so that we may address their concerns."

Chinese Company, Sinoma at Slurry PPC Plough Back

Slurry Primary School is the Quintile three school located at Slurry in the PPC premises. The Sinoma CBMI Company presented the school with a handing-over ceremony led by Liu from SINOMA and his management team following the school's request for donation in 2020. The school received assembly structure/shelter, carport, school name board and a projector. The product that was presented was by far beyond the school expectation, expedition and excellent workmanship; as well as superior quality of material used. The principal of the school Senatle appreciated and acknowledged the support of SINOMA has given the school since 2017 when they started their business partnership with PPC. "This is what we call 'ngwana sejo wa tlhakanelwa, investing in the education of an African child. In 2017 Sinoma donated learner desks, netball court, a deep freezer, microwave oven and renovated a classroom to be used as a kitchen. Our Ward Cllr Mr Pule Mokgele also thanked the company very well. Thank you Sinoma, thank you PPC," she said. This school serves the Matsatseng community and the nearby farms. Matsatseng is one of the poorest communities, an informal settlement about 25km outside Mahikeng. It can be seen along the R49 road to Zeerust.
